Judges will not wait for ANY dog holding up a class. Exhibitors and handlers with more than one dog must have an alternate handler available so that judging will not be delayed.

The figure before each breed in this schedule represents the number of dogs entered in that breed. The figures following each breed indicate the number of dogs entered in (1) regular male classes; (2) veteran male classes; (3) regular female classes; (4) veteran female classes; (5) male Specials; (6) female Specials.
